

From 28 April to 1 May 2023, the FIAAC en Pouilly Fumé will celebrate its 10th anniversary!

Since 2013 the FIAAC en PF has been the joint venture of artists, art lovers, and vintners of an *appellation* known around the world. Fifteen artists are selected every year to exhibit for **4 days** in the wine cellars of 15 vintners. These large, individual exhibitions are held in spacious sites that range from ultra-modern to traditional, and in all cases show the work off to advantage. Every year since 2003 our visitor count has increased and every year the quality of the wine and the artists, though different, is appreciated by wine and art lovers alike, who take advantage of the first long weekend in May to add to their collections!

To conclude the event, a jury of people well known in the French art world awards **the Grand Prix de la FIAAC en Pouilly Fumé** to one of the artists and the **Zeuxis Prize*** to the best exhibition (artist + vintner). The artists then award the **Dionysos Prize** to one of the participating vintners.

ORGANIZATION

Artists are selected by a committee composed of **art specialists** and the officers of our non-profit organization. Their criteria are the originality, consistency, and of course the quality of the works. At the same time, based on the works alone, each vintner chooses the artist they would like to have exhibit in their wine cellar. The list of selected artists will be distributed in **early January 2023**.

The night before the FIAAC (27 April 2023), each vintner and “their” artist team up to install the exhibition. Picture rails, picture hangers, and lighting are provided by the vintners, who also provide **free accommodations for the artist** and a guest. Artists and vintners welcome visitors together during opening hours. The artists are free to set their prices and pay no commission on their sales. Artists are responsible for transporting and insuring their works. **All additional information will be sent to the selected artists in 2023.**

APPLICATION

To participate, artists (painters) must send a **digital file by email** (completed application, CV, and photos of 10 paintings) **plus a file by post** (see below for the list of items to provide) **before midnight on 15 November 2022**. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed and no applications will be taken by phone.

- **1 ID photo** with your full name (civil status and pseudonym)
- **1 CV** listing your exhibitions and a short description of your artistic approach (1,000 characters max.)
- **10 color photos** of the paintings you intend to exhibit and the format, technique, and date of each one.

Each photo must be a separate attachment in .jpg format, and less than 1 MO.

Above all, **no CDs or exhaustive catalogues of your work.**
